STATE TREASURER FLEMING COMMENDS THE STATE BOND COMMISSION:

Baton Rouge, LA — The Louisiana State Bond Commission approved election applications for the following parishes: Allen, Ascension, Beauregard, Bossier, Calcasieu, Catahoula, East Baton Rouge, East Carroll, Iberia, Iberville, Jackson, Jefferson, Lincoln, Livingston, Morehouse, Orleans, Ouachita, Plaquemines, Rapides, St. James, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Terrebonne, Vernon and Washington. The State Bond Commission approval, which is not an endorsement of any application, is required before the Secretary of State's office can place certain propositions on the ballot.



Dr. Fleming recommends all Louisiana residents visit LaCashClaim.org and search the website to find out if you have unclaimed property. According to Dr. Fleming, "One in six individuals in Louisiana has unclaimed property, with claims averaging \$900. It is your money; we want you to claim it." There is currently \$1.2 billion in unclaimed property to return to Louisiana citizens.
