**LA Treasury unclaimed money webinar for businesses has  
640+ registered, and there's still time to join**

***Free online event is set for September 1 at 10 AM CST***

**BATON ROUGE, LA** – The Louisiana Department of Treasury will host a free online seminar to assist businesses with unclaimed money law compliance and reporting requirements. The 2022 Unclaimed Property Holder Webinar will take place online on September 1 from 10-11:30 AM CST. To date, there are more than 640 registered, and there is still time to sign up to attend.

“We want Louisiana’s businesses to know how to get unclaimed holdings to our Unclaimed Property division so our staff can do what they do best – get money to its rightful owners!” said State Treasurer John M. Schroder.

He added that all businesses operating in the state are required by law to report unclaimed property. However, most businesses may not realize this fact.

“We want to get the word out and educate the business community on its responsibilities regarding abandoned accounts,” Schroder said.
