Treasurer John M. Schroder extends loggers relief grant application deadline

BATON ROUGE, LA - Louisiana State Treasurer John M. Schroder announced that the <u>Louisiana Loggers Relief Grant Program</u> application deadline has been extended to Friday, November 4. Designed to alleviate the economic strain caused by the Covid-19 pandemic on the state's logging industry, this second round of the program features one-time grants of up to \$25,000. Some eligibility requirements have changed, so previously-denied applicants may now qualify.

Full eligibility requirements can be found at <u>LATreasury.com</u> Qualifying businesses must have experienced a loss of gross revenue from January 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020, compared to the 2019 gross revenue of the business.

Logging companies that previously received a grant of the \$25,000 maximum amount during the original Louisiana Loggers Relief program are not eligible.
